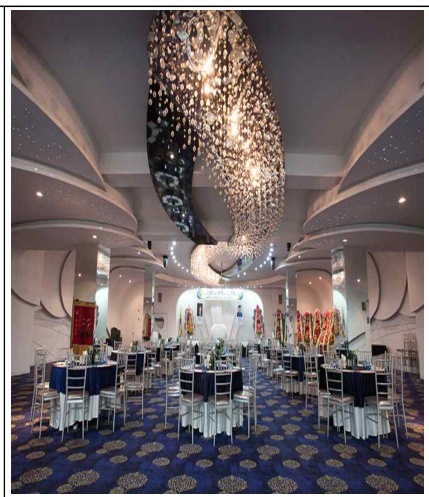

3. Eligibility

- Invitation
 - Basically, the invitation targets countries/territories joining to International Go Federation. However, KBF has the right to invite.
- Qualification of Nationality
 - Each player must have the nationality of the country/territory he or she represents.
 - The player with a different nationality can be also allowed to participate **only if** his/her Go Organization guarantees the identification by submitting the document to show he/she has participated in other tournaments as the country/territory' s player.
 - If he/she has ever participated in a tournament as a representative for a different country/territory, the participation should be **never allowed.**

- Qualification of participation
 - All players must be amateur and recognized by their belonging Baduk organization.
 - **Two divisions for the championship**: National and Youth (U15).
 - Each country/territory can send each representative player for each division: National Division and Youth (U15) Division.
- The youth player should be born on November 6, 2010 or later.

4. Tournament Rules

○ Common Notice

- Timers and game recorders will be used for all games.
- **Using electronic devices would be prohibited** during the match.
- Stopping the timer to use the bathroom is allowed only once per game.
**If you have any unavoidable issue like disease, please contact the staff in advance.*
- Tie break: WINS > SOS > SOSOS

1) KPMC Championship

- Tournament: **7 round Swiss System**
- Time limit: **40 minutes + Fischer time 20 seconds** increment per move
- Rule: All Even games, 6.5 points Dum(=Komi)

5. Participation fee

1) Fee for the invited

○ The Invited: Free of charge

- 1) one national and one U15 representative player from each country
- 2) the invited executives by Korea Baduk Federation

2) Participation fee for the guests

○ Guest fee: ~~700,000~~ 500,000 KRW (Korean 'WON' cash only)

- The fee will be used to provide the paid guests with accommodation (7 nights), breakfast, banquet, transfer, etc. same as the invited.
- The guest fee should be given to the organizer at the reception desk and only KRW cash would be available.
- The guest will share the room with his/her player or executive.
- The guest fee for each group will be explained via email to tell how the total fee should be after the registration period.

7. Provided Services (accommodation, meals, etc.)

1) Meals and accommodation

- Shown on the schedule would be provided.
- Unfortunately, the government (sponsor) has not allowed KBF to use the budget to provide lunch and dinner for participants in order to vitalize local economy, so only breakfast and banquet would be provided.
- Following the decreased services, guest fee has decreased as above.
- If you have any special dietary needs, you should write a **detailed description** (*cf: No meat, but fish is available*) on the registration form.

2) Transfer

- The participants should come to the hotel by themselves as the hotel could not provide shuttle bus service.
- After Nov. 7, buses will be provided to transfer participants to the venue like a gymnasium and tourism.

** Please notice all responsibilities caused by unknown or incorrect information would lie with the people themselves.*

8. Requests

1) Visa and Invitation

- If you need a Korean Visa, please check required documents with the Korean Embassy at first, and let us know if there is any document that needs to be prepared by the KBF when submitting the Visa application.
- The official invitation would require name of the invited, National Go Association the person belongs to, the address including his / her city, and postal (zip) code. If any problem occurs by wrong information, its responsibility would be to you.

Please notice that international delivery fee should be paid by you.

2) Dress code for ceremonies

- All players are recommended **not** to wear t-shirts, jeans or similar attire during the ceremonies.

3) Anti-doping test

- Randomly selected some of the top players must accept the anti-doping test when required.

4) Emergency

- When any emergency occurs, please contact the staffs.

5) No misrepresentation & Stricter identification

- Associations in each country should thoroughly identify the participants and guarantee them, who should be qualified for the representative of your country. If participants of each country cause the following troubles that result in disorder during the timeframe, KBF may hold their associations responsible for it or further invitation may be restricted or revoked.

〈Example of trouble〉

- (1) Doing illegal acts (violence, sex crime, theft, etc.)
- (2) Staying in Korea illegally without returning to home country
- (3) Refusing to comply with the legitimate instructions of the competition manager
(*cf: constant lateness for the meeting time, disobedient with the proper judgment by the referee, etc.*)
- (4) Any other acts to undermine the dignity of the representative of each country significantly
